

ORDER FORM for Transcribed 2003 Edition of Claiborne Family Journal

Dr. Christopher J. Cleborne's The Claiborne Family Journal was started in 1877 when he began the research by corresponding with various Claiborne families. His last entry appears to be about 1906. In the book Sue Forbes has written a page about the author and the Journal. George Mason Claiborne believed that Dr. C. J. Cleborne was recognized as the highest authority on Claiborne genealogy. The Claiborne Family Journal was 309 handwritten 11" x 17" pages, including about 67 pedigree charts of many Claiborne, Cleburne and Cliburne families and a 16 page Index. There are 5 introductory pages to the Journal. It has been transcribed and printed with a total of 145 (8 ½ x 11) pages. The Claiborne Family Journal was found in a secretary desk at an estate sale in 1950-1960's and was given to Dr. Thomas Claiborne's uncle, Randolph Royal Claiborne, Jr. of Atlanta, GA. Dr. Claiborne brought a copy to the Claiborne Clan Reunion in Williamsburg, VA in 1997. The original copy is at the Atlanta History Center in Atlanta, GA.
